

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your PRO VAC is a new concept in flexible pool vacuum design. A suction chamber created by the flex strips under the PRO VAC body will concentrate the vacuum velocity equally from both ends as well as front to back. By moving your vacuum slowly over the pool bottom, any debris will be guided into this suction chamber where it is quickly removed. You will soon discover the proper speed to maneuver your PRO VAC and how much faster you can clean your pool.

It is not recommended that PRO VAC be used to vacuum steps. Simply brush any step areas before vacuuming the pool. Your flexible PRO VAC is constructed of high quality polyethylene with an ultra violet ray inhibitor added. This helps repel the damaging effects of sunlight on the life of the material. However, we recommend you store your PRO VAC out of sunlight when not in use. The PRO VAC has been fully assembled and ready for use. There are a few points that need to be mentioned . . .

BLUE - Long leg strip - For sand, silt or fine debris.

WHITE - Short leg strip - For large or normal debris.

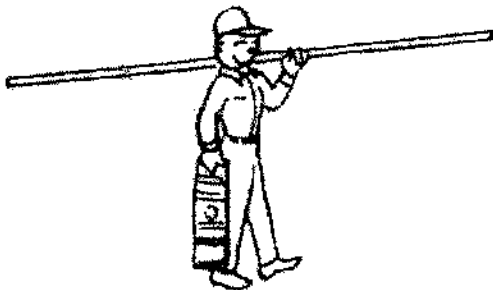
### WHEEL ADJUSTMENT

All wheels should be equally adjusted to their lowest position so the PRO VAC body is at its highest position. Tighten wheels securely. Begin vacuuming in this position. If you require increased vacuum velocity (more suction), raise each wheel equally to the desired position and re-tighten. This will lower the PRO VAC closer to the pool bottom, creating more vacuum velocity. To decrease simply reverse the process and lower the wheels to raise the PRO VAC. NOTE: If your PRO VAC becomes "clamped" to the pool bottom due to worn wheels or excessive vacuum, turn off the pump to free the vacuum.

Replace worn wheels and flex strips when necessary.

### VAC HOSE CONNECTION

The PRO VAC includes 2" and 1½" hose adapters that fit onto the manifold assembly. Connect vacuum hose to proper size adapter. It is recommended your vac hose be 3' to 5' longer than point of connection to the furthest point of the pool



Note: Do not carry cleaner on end of pole.  
Remove and carry cleaner from end.
